"We have the right to feel safe in [your town]"

"Hey stranger, don't call me baby!"

"My name is not, 'Yo, Shorty!""

"Treat us as equals, not as sex objects"

"I love my community. I want to feel safe"

"I am....mothers, sister, daughter"

"I need your respect"

"These are my streets too"

"Take back the day"

"Street harassment of women has been silenced for too long"

"I am your sister, not a hoe, bitch or slut"

"It's not a compliment. It's street harassment."

"I'm not a dog, don't whistle at me"

"My body is not public property"

"Would you like it if someone followed your sister down the street?"

"Black men, the cops harass you, then why do you harass black women?"

"Hello, my name is not 'Hey Baby"

"Catcalls are not compliments"

"Flirting. Harassment. Real men know the difference"

"If clothes cause harassment...plates make people fat, cars make people drive drunk, and pens misspell words."

"No more harassment, our streets too!"

"More than 80% of women worldwide and many LGBQT individuals face street harassment. Speak out."

"Nearly 25% of 12-year-old girls face street harassment! Let's stop this now."
